Benefit Update

Medical Coverage

Effective January 1st, 2023 Aetna will no longer be offered to UAW Trust members. To make this transition easier, you will automatically be enrolled in a new Trust-sponsored Medicare Advantage plan offered through United Healthcare (UHC) on January 1, 2023 if you were enrolled in Aetna. There is no action required by you for this enrollment. The UHC MA plan is a Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) with Extended Service Area (ESA). This means that the plan allows you to use any doctors and hospitals that are licensed to receive Medicare payment and willing to accept your plan regardless of whether they participate in the UHC network without paying higher out-of-network costs. You do have options. If after consideration of this new plan, you prefer to enroll in the Blue Cross Blue Shield (BCBS) Traditional Care Network (TCN) plan, simply let us know by contacting Retiree Health Care Connect (RHCC) at 866-637-7555 between September 6 and November 30, 2022. If you select the TCN plan for 2023, Medicare will be primary and BCBS is secondary. It is important to check that your doctors and hospitals participate in the BCBS network. You will always have lower costs when you use in-network providers.

Prescription Coverage

Effective January 1st, 2023 Express Scripts will no longer be offered to UAW Trust members. Your prescription drug coverage for 2023 will be administered by OptumRx regardless of which medical plan you choose. You'll receive more information regarding your prescription drug coverage later this fall. To use mail order through Optum Rx, you may need a new prescription from your Dr(s). Please work with your Drs to write new prescriptions for your medications prior to January to avoid any delay in receiving your prescription drug medications in 2023. If your current retail pharmacy participates in the Optum Rx pharmacy network, you will not need to obtain a new prescription from your Dr(s). It is important to check with your pharmacy to see if they participate in Optum Rx.

Beginning August 1, the Trust will be hosting free, daily informational sessions available by phone or webcast to learn about all of the 2023 benefit changes. These sessions will be live and provide the opportunity to hear Trust representatives explain your benefits and answer your questions. Postcards will be sent in the upcoming weeks on how to register for a session.

On Tuesday October 11th,2022 the UAW Medical Benefit Trust and United Healthcare will be at the retiree monthly meeting. We strongly encourage you to attend to answer all questions and get the detailed information. A reminder these changes will not take place until January 1st,2023.


2nd Annual UAW Local 774 Golf Tournament

Raffle Tickets for Roswell Park's Herd of Hope and the Leukemia Lymphoma Society

The Community Services Committee has decided to have a prize raffle and a meat raffle this year on 2 separate dates. After our September Executive Board meeting on September 16, 2022, we will hold a raffle upstairs in the meeting hall. Then eight days later, on September 24, 2022, we will have our meat raffle at The Woodlawn Fire Company. The Proceeds are going to go toward Roswell Park's Herd of Hope and the Leukemia Lymphoma Society's (LLS) Light the Night walk.

Research conducted at Roswell Park has led to historic breakthroughs in the way they understand, prevent and cure cancer, and today they are one of the leading cancer facilities in the country. The Herd of Hope was created to build awareness of the research taking place at Roswell Park while raising funds to advance innovative ideas that have the potential to make a significant difference in the fight against cancer. The Herd is local companies coming together as one to fund promising team science research at Roswell Park with one common goal: "Finding a Cure for Cancer!!!"

Light The Night is LLS's annual walk and fundraising event and the nation's night to pay tribute and bring hope to people battling cancer.

We are hosting a Prize Raffle, to be held at our UAW Local 774 union hall on September 16, 2022, with the proceeds going to both Roswell's Herd of Hope and LLS. UAW International Officer Elections

The UAW Referendum that was held in 2021, established new procedures for electing International Officers of the UAW. UAW members now have the opportunity to directly vote for the leaders they chose.

The 2022 UAW International Officer Elections will be conducted by secret mail in ballots. The Court-Appointed Monitor will supervise the election according to the new rules set forth and the methods for the elections.

The monitor and the IEB are working together to ensure all eligible members can vote. Ballot packages will be mailed between the middle of October 2022 until October 31, 2022.

All UAW members in good standing as well as retired members are eligible to vote. Your packet will be issued by the Merriam River Group (MRG), and they will distribute, collect, and tabulate the votes. Please make sure your mailing address is correct at UAW Local 774 Union hall.

The offices that will be filled by this vote are: International President, Secretary Treasurer, 3 International Vice Presidents and 9 Regional Directors. The UAW delegates to the Constitutional Convention, (Local 774's Delegates Wence Valentin III, Cleveland Jones Jr., and Roberta Gainer) will be a part of the nomination process.

To have your mail-in vote counted, it must be received by November 28, 2022. I highly encourage you to not only vote, but to mail your ballot no later than November 18 to ensure they get delivered on time.

PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR UPDATED MAILING AND E-MAIL ADDRESS INFORMATION TO YOUR LOCAL UNION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND ADVISE YOUR FELLOW MEMBERS TO DO THE SAME. IF YOU ARE A NEW MEMBER WHO HAS RECENTLY JOINED THE UAW, YOU MUST MAKE SURE YOUR LOCAL UNION HAS YOUR INFORMATION. IF YOU ARE NOT PRESENTLY IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE UNION AND WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ELECTION, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO IMMEDIATELY REMEDY THAT SITUATION, INCLUDING CURING ANY DUES DELINQUENCIES, TO HAVE YOUR VOTE COUNT.
