ELECTION OF DELEGATES TO THE UAW 38th Constitutional Convention

Elect three (3) Delegates and three (3) Alternate Delegates

DATE: Tuesday June 14, 2022
TIME: 5:300 AM to 12:00 AM - MIDNIGHT
PLACE: UAW Local 774 Union Hall - 2939 Niagara St.
Buffalo, NY 14207 – Downstairs

In the case of a run-off, the election will take place one week later on Tuesday June 21, 2022

Acceptances & Nominations

Per Article 8, Section 11 of the UAW Constitution, all members in good standing may accept nomination.

Nominations will be accepted from: **Tuesday May 31, 2022 at 10:30 AM**
 Until: **Tuesday June 7, 2022 at 10:30 AM**

At that time, the acceptance box will be opened and positions on the ballot will be selected. These acceptances must be submitted in writing at the Union Hall, 2939 Niagara St. Buffalo, NY 14207.

Any member may nominate any other member(s), he or she desires for **Delegate** or **Alternate Delegate** in this election. Where a member chooses to nominate another member, he/she is required to notify the local union of his nomination in writing, within the nominating period. He/she is also required to notify the member that he/she has been nominated for the Delegate or Alternate Delegate, so that his/her nominee will be aware of the nomination and the nominee must accept the nomination within the nominating period. If a member is nominated and the nominator fails to notify the nominee, this failure will not invalidate or excuse the member's responsibility to accept nomination as Delegate or Alternate Delegate for which which he/she was nominated within the established deadline period.

Confirmation of nominations will be until Tuesday June 7, 2022 at 12:00 AM - Midnight ONLY to confirm nominations and those nominations made by members OTHER than the candidate. Any candidate who denies acceptance will be removed from the ballot, moving all candidates under that person up in ballot position. Candidates and ballot positions will be posted on Wednesday morning June 8, 2022.

Delegates and Alternate Delegates will be ranked by their vote totals. UAW Local 774's voting strength at the convention is (11) votes.

The Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act requires that a Local Union is obligated, upon reasonable request of any candidate, to distribute by mail at the candidate's expense, campaign literature in aid of such person's candidacy to members in good standing of such labor organization.
